Shea's Performing Arts Center Announces Winners of the Shea's High School Musical Awards Program

Twenty WNY High Schools & Over 1,300 Students Participated
Two WNY Students Headed to National Competition in NYC

During an event at Shea's Buffalo Theatre on May 25, 2024, Shea's Performing Arts Center announced the winners of the Shea's High School Musical Awards program.

"Shea's is proud to support opportunities for performing arts education, which provides lessons that transcend the stage," said Brian Higgins, Shea's Performing Arts Center President & CEO. "All of these students have worked so hard and deserve a round of applause. It's great to see Western New York's young talent on display."

This year Shea's Performing Arts Center expanded the High School Musical Theatre Awards program allowing participation to double from 10 to 20 schools. Participating students had the opportunity to take part in workshops, a college fair, and other learning experiences in recent weeks. Nominations in a <u>variety of categories</u> were <u>revealed on April 25</u>.
