Home Alone II: Lost in New York was also a worldwide success.Culkin's film credits include Rocket Gibralter, Uncle Buck, My Girl and the independent film Changeland. He also starred in the feature film Saved! produced by Michael Stipe and as Michael Alig in the cult-favorite Party Monster both of which premiered at the Sundance Film Festival. His television credits include American Horror Story: Installment 10 for FX, The Righteous Gemstones for HBO Max, Kings, and Robot Chicken. Culkin was also a performer in the band The Pizza Underground and founded the media empire Bunny Ears which included a Podcast, website, live events and merchandising components.
