But now, with the upcoming Symphony of Seasons, we'll hear the music in a bigger and grander way, with a larger orchestra and additional songs from the game. I'm really looking forward to it!"*

Once again, fans are encouraged to come dressed in their best Stardew Valley cosplay in this celebration of the game, and new exclusive merchandise will also be available for purchase.
