## ELEVATE SHEA'S: RISING TOGETHER CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The Elevate Shea's expansion project is officially underway! Since breaking ground in March, crews have been hard at work on site preparation, excavation, and the early phases of utility connections, literally laying the groundwork for Shea's Buffalo's next century as we celebrate our 100th anniversary.

Staff and crew have affectionately nicknamed the exposed underground site "The Pit" – a fitting theatrical reference for a project rooted in the performing arts. Like an orchestra pit, which supports stage performance, the booming construction equipment echoes the sounds of progress, and the work sets the stage for the future of Shea's itself.

Next week marks another major milestone as pile installation begins, marking the first visible sign of the Shea's Buffalo expansion project rising from the ground.

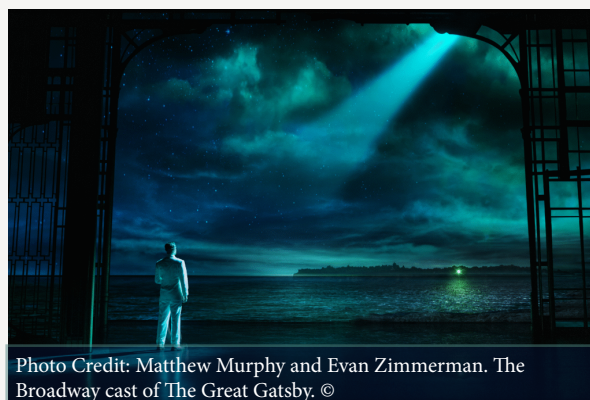

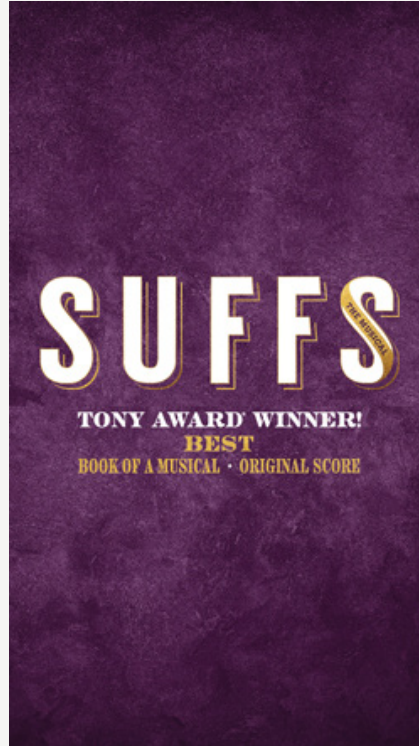

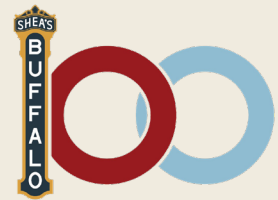
## ARTHUR MILLER'S DEATH OF A SALESMAN
