This week, Shea's Performing Arts Center reached an incredible milestone. Friday January 16th marked the Centennial Anniversary of the opening of Shea's Buffalo Theatre. Just as the public was welcomed in to the theatre exactly one hundred years ago, the community was welcomed in to Shea's Buffalo once again to share the milestone!

The Centennial Celebration took place in Shea's Grand Lobby and the Shea's Buffalo Stage, featuring live entertainment from D.J. Milk, Curtis Cook on the Wurlitzer, IOT Band (featuring Shea's Staff member and Band member, Bill Hedrick), performances from Shea's Staff members Rachael Buchanan, Equasia Jennings, and Julianna Tracey, and performances from several local theatre partners.



Tickets for the event included a champagne toast, heavy hors d'oeuvres, photo opportunities from the stage, and more. Proceeds from the event went to benefit Shea's for the next 100 years.

We're kicking off our first collaboration of 2026 with 42 North! Those who attended the Centennial Celebration were the first to get a taste of the new Wonder Beer.




After its debut, the Wonder Beer will be available at Shea's venues, local bars and restaurants across Buffalo, and retail locations wherever fine craft beer is sold.



SHEA'S ORIGINAL TIME CAPSULE.

OUR HIDDEN, WURLITZER TIME CAPSULE!

To celebrate 100 years, Shea's is putting together a time capsule to be opened in the next 100 years! While we are incredibly excited for this new time capsule, did you know there is already one at Shea's?

If you were to go inside our Mighty Wurlitzer Organ, you would find a small, old whiskey bottle. According to a note left by Dave Vanderhoek, Curt Mangel, and Gordon Gillette, the bottle was discovered behind the east wall wood pipes of the Foundation Chamber in May 1979. They believed it was left by the original Wurlitzer installation crew in 1926. During the restoration of Shea's Buffalo, the bottle was then used as a "conversation piece and time capsule for future organ workers."

The bottle, unopened since 1980, has certainly served as a conversation piece! Our stagehands treat it with a bit of superstition, keeping it sealed and even rubbing it for good luck.

The bottle has remained unopened for about 45 years. Perhaps one day in the future, we'll discover what was left inside!
